

**COMMUNIQUE BY NATIONAL TRIPARTITE COMMITTEE (NTC)**  
**ON THE 2015 NATIONAL DAILY MINIMUM WAGE**

The National Tripartite Committee (NTC) concluded consultations on the 2015 National Daily Minimum Wage (NDMW) at its meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2015.


It was agreed that the National Daily Minimum Wage be increased by **16.7%** that is, from GHC6.00 to **GHC7.00**

The effective date of implementation is 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2015.


Any establishment, institution or organization whose **daily minimum wage** is below the new National Daily Minimum Wage should adjust its wages upward accordingly.


The National Tripartite Committee recommends that the National Daily Minimum Wage should be tax exempt.
