COMMUNIQUE BY NATIONAL TRIPARTITE COMMITTEE (NTC)
ON THE 2016 NATIONAL DAILY MINIMUM WAGE

The National Tripartite Committee (NTC) at its meeting held on Friday, 2nd October, 2015 concluded consultations on the 2016 National Daily Minimum Wage (NDMW).


It was agreed that the National Daily Minimum Wage for 2016 be increased by 14.29%, that is, from **GHC7.00** to **GHC8.00**.


The effective date of implementation is 1st January, 2016.


Any establishment, institution or organization whose Daily Minimum Wage is below the new National Daily Minimum Wage should adjust its wages upward, accordingly.

The National Tripartite Committee recommends that the National Daily Minimum Wage should be tax exempt, and impresses upon all establishments to endeavour to comply.

The National Tripartite Committee reiterates its commitment to the improvement of incomes and productivity in both the public and private sectors of the Economy.
